A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Correctional Training Commission – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Maryland Correctional Training
4 Commission to include the Director of the Division of Parole and Probation within
5 the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services; and generally relating to
6 the membership of the Maryland Correctional Training Commission.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article – Correctional Services

10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (2017 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Correctional Services**

15 8–204.

16 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:

17 (1) the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

18 (2) the Secretary of Juvenile Services;

19 (3) a representative of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional
20 Services, designated by the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

1 (4) a representative of the Department of Juvenile Services, designated by
2 the Secretary of Juvenile Services;

3 (5) a Deputy Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;

4 (6) the president of the Maryland Correctional Administrators Association;

5 (7) the president of the Maryland Sheriffs Association;

6 (8) the president of the Maryland Criminal Justice Association;

7 (9) the Attorney General of the State;

8 (10) the president of a university or college in the State with a correctional
9 education curriculum, appointed by the Maryland Higher Education Commission;

10 (11) one correctional officer of the State recommended by the exclusive
11 representative for the officers covered under Title 10, Subtitle 9 of this article and
12 appointed by the Governor; **[and]**

13 (12) five correctional officers or officials appointed under subsection (c) of
14 this section; **AND**

15 **(13) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION**
16 **WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.**

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2025.
