1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Research Duties and Advisory Committee on Black Males –**
3 **Repeal**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that the Office of Small, Minority, and Women
5 Business Affairs conduct research, make recommendations, and submit a certain
6 report on certain areas relating to black males; repealing the authorization for the
7 Special Secretary of Small, Minority, and Women Business Affairs to create an
8 Advisory Committee on Black Males; and generally relating to the Office of Small,
9 Minority, and Women Business Affairs and issues relating to black males.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Government**

18 **[9–303.2.**

19 (a) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Office shall conduct
20 necessary and appropriate research to determine the nature and extent of the problems
21 concerning black males and offer recommendations exclusively pertinent to black males in
22 the areas of:

1 (1) unemployment;

2 (2) criminal justice;

3 (3) education; and

4 (4) health.

5 (b) As authorized by the Governor, the Special Secretary may create an Advisory
6 Committee on Black Males to assist and advise the Office in developing recommendations
7 in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

8 (c) The Office shall submit its findings and recommendations in accordance with
9 this section to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1257 of this article, the General Assembly
10 on or before January 1, 1995 and annually thereafter.]

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2025.
