

- 5 (II) AN ORGANIZATION'S REPRESENTATIVE SEAT MAY BE 6 REMOVED IF THE ORGANIZATION FAILS TO APPOINT A NEW COMMISSIONER FOR 2 7 CONTINUOUS YEARS.
- 8 **(6)** AN ORGANIZATION MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE COMMISSION IF 9 A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE ORGANIZATION IS NOT RECOMMENDED BY THAT 10 ORGANIZATION.
- 11 (d) [A new organization may not be eligible for representation on the Commission, 12 by appointment of the Governor, unless it is congressionally chartered] A MAJORITY OF 13 THE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.
