- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.

15 Article - Public Safety

- 17 (a) Officers, warrant officers, and enlisted individuals who are full-time 18 employees of the Department are in State active duty status.
- 19 (b) (1) The [Governor] **ADJUTANT GENERAL** may appoint a chief of staff and 20 aides.



- 1 (2) The chief of staff and aides serve at the pleasure of the [Governor] 2 ADJUTANT GENERAL.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2025.
