Article - Education 15

- 17 Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, an individual shall be 18 exempt from paying the out-of-state tuition rate at a public institution of higher education 19 in the State, and shall be eligible for the tuition rates described under subsections (c) and 20 (d) of this section, if the individual:
- 21Provides to the public institution of higher education documentation 22 that the individual or the individual's parent or legal guardian has filed a Maryland income
