4 FOR the purpose of increasing the scholarship award for a student member of the Anne
5 Arundel County Board of Education who completes a full term on the county board;
6 and generally relating to the scholarship for the student member of the Anne
7 Arundel County Board of Education.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

2 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board of Education consists of:

3 (1) Seven nonpartisan elected members; and

4 (2) One student member.

5 3-2A-07.

6 (a) The president of the county board is entitled to receive \$17,000 annually as
7 compensation, the vice president is entitled to receive \$16,000 annually as compensation,
8 and, except for the student member, the other board members are entitled to receive
9 \$15,000 each annually as compensation.

10 (b) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall be
11 granted a scholarship of [~~\$8,000~~] **\$15,000** to be applied toward the student's higher
12 education costs.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
14 1, 2025.
