BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 Article - Criminal Law 15 3-708. 16 In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. (a) (1) "IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER" INCLUDES: 17 (2)18 **(I)** A PARENT; 19 (II)A SPOUSE; AND 20 (III) A CHILD.

SENATE BILL 311

1 "Local official" means an individual serving in a publicly elected office **(3)** 2 of a local government unit, as defined in § 10–101 of the State Government Article. 3 [(3)] **(4)** "State official" has the meaning stated in § 5–101 of the (i) 4 General Provisions Article. "State official" 5 (ii) includes the Governor. Governor-elect. 6 Lieutenant Governor, and Lieutenant Governor-elect. "Threat" includes: 7 [(4)] (5) 8 (i) an oral threat; or 9 a threat in any written form, whether or not the writing is signed, (ii) 10 or if the writing is signed, whether or not it is signed with a fictitious name or any other 11 mark. 12 A person may not knowingly and willfully make a threat to take the life of, (b) 13 kidnap, or cause physical injury to: 14 **(1)** a State official[,]; 15 **(2)** a local official[,]; 16 **(3)** a deputy State's Attorney[,]; 17 **(4)** an assistant State's Attorney[, or]; **(5)** an assistant Public Defender; OR 18 19 **(6)** AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL LISTED IN 20ITEM (1), (2), (3), (4), OR (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION. 21A person may not knowingly send, deliver, part with, or make for the purpose 22of sending or delivering a threat prohibited under subsection (b) of this section. 23 A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$2,500 or both. 2425SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2025.
