15 (a) A person may not obscure or modify any vehicle registration plate [with intent 16 to avoid] IN A MANNER THAT MAY PREVENT identification.

- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2025.
