- (2) prepare a report that includes:
- 6 (i) key findings from the Workgroup's analysis conducted under 7 paragraph (1) of this subsection; and
- 8 (ii) recommendations regarding solutions to eliminate food deserts 9 in the State.
- 10 (g) On or before November 1, 2025, the Workgroup shall submit the report of its 11 findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the 12 State Government Article, the General Assembly, the Senate Committee on Education, 13 Energy, and the Environment, the Senate Finance Committee, the House Economic 14 Matters Committee, and the House Environment and Transportation Committee.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 16 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2026, this 17 Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no 18 further force and effect.
