1 AN ACT concerning

Agriculture – Roosters – Restrictions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting, unless authorized by the Department of Agriculture, a certain person from keeping a certain number of roosters on certain property beginning on a certain date, subject to certain exceptions; authorizing the Department to work in cooperation with a local animal control or law enforcement officer to enforce this Act; and generally relating to restrictions on keeping roosters in the State.

- WHEREAS, Despite its illegality in Maryland, ongoing issues persist with cockfighting; and
- WHEREAS, Breeding roosters for cockfighting is directly linked to the spread of Avian Flu; now, therefore,
- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 28 **(F)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY WORK IN COOPERATION WITH A LOCAL ANIMAL CONTROL OR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION.

- 1 (G) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE THE 2 DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT ADDITIONAL INSPECTIONS BEYOND THOSE 3 INSPECTIONS REQUIRED BY LAW.
- 4 (H) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 5 SECTION.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2025.
