1 AN ACT concerning

2 Health Facilities – Delegation of Inspection Authority – Nursing Homes

FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Health, on request of a county, to delegate
to the county the authority to conduct site visits and full surveys and complaint
investigations of nursing homes; requiring the Maryland Department of Health to
execute a certain memorandum of understanding with a requesting county within a
certain period of time; requiring that the Maryland Department of Health and
certain counties equally share certain costs under certain circumstances; and
generally relating to the inspection of nursing homes and the delegation of authority.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SENATE BILL 376

1 (a) (1) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, the Department shall make a 2 site visit and conduct a full survey of each licensed nursing home at least once per calendar 3 year.

4 (2) Unless otherwise required by federal law, all surveys shall be 5 unannounced.

6 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Department shall 7 initiate an investigation of a nursing home complaint alleging actual harm within 10 8 business days after receiving the complaint.

9 (2) If the Department receives a complaint against a nursing home alleging 10 immediate jeopardy to a resident, the Department:

(i) Shall make every effort to investigate the complaint within 24hours after receiving the complaint; and

(ii) Shall investigate the complaint not later than 48 hours afterreceiving the complaint.

15 (c) If ownership of a licensed nursing home is transferred to a person that does 16 not own or operate another nursing home in the State at the time of the transfer, the 17 Department shall conduct:

18 (1) The first full survey of the licensed nursing home as required under
19 subsection (a) of this section within 3 months after the date of transfer; and

20 (2) An unannounced, on-site follow-up survey of the licensed nursing 21 home that covers any deficiencies noted in the full survey within 120 days after the full 22 survey was completed.

(D) (1) ON REQUEST OF A COUNTY, THE SECRETARY SHALL DELEGATE TO
 THE COUNTY THE AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT SITE VISITS AND FULL SURVEYS AND
 <u>COMPLAINT INVESTIGATIONS</u> OF NURSING HOMES <u>AUTHORIZED</u> UNDER THIS
 SECTION.
