14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 **INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY**
3 **GENERAL UNDER § 6-602 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE; AND**

4 **(2) MAKE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS THAT THE COMMISSION**
5 **DETERMINES ARE APPROPRIATE BASED ON ITS REVIEW.**
