## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### $\mathbf{2}$ **Carroll County – Office of Permits and Inspections – Denial of Commercial** 3 Permit or License for Unpaid Personal Property Taxes

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Carroll County Office of Permits and Inspections from  $\mathbf{5}$ issuing or renewing a commercial license or permit in the county if the applicant has 6 unpaid personal property taxes except under certain circumstances; authorizing the 7 Carroll County Office of Permits and Inspections to issue or renew a commercial 8 license or permit if the applicant submits certain evidence that the applicant has 9 paid any previously unpaid personal property taxes; and generally relating to the issuance or renewal of commercial licenses and permits in Carroll County. 10

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 17That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### **Article – Local Government**

20THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO CARROLL COUNTY. (A)

21 (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW AND SUBJECT **(B)** 22TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE CARROLL COUNTY OFFICE OF 23PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS MAY DENY THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A

1 COMMERCIAL LICENSE OR PERMIT IN THE COUNTY IF THE APPLICANT HAS UNPAID 2 PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

3 (2) THE CARROLL COUNTY OFFICE OF PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS 4 MAY NOT DENY THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A COMMERCIAL LICENSE OR PERMIT 5 FOR UNPAID PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 6 SUBSECTION IF THE APPLICANT SUBMITS EVIDENCE TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE 7 OFFICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS DISPUTED THE AMOUNT OF UNPAID PERSONAL 8 PROPERTY TAXES.

9 (C) THE CARROLL COUNTY OFFICE OF PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS MAY 10 ISSUE OR RENEW A COMMERCIAL LICENSE OR PERMIT IN THE COUNTY THAT WAS 11 DENIED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION IF THE APPLICANT SUBMITS 12 EVIDENCE TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE OFFICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS PAID 13 ANY PREVIOUSLY UNPAID PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2025.
