1 AN ACT concerning

2 Anne Arundel County – Office of the Inspector General – Establishment

FOR the purpose of requiring the Anne Arundel County Council to establish an Office of
the Inspector General in the county; requiring the County Council to enact a certain
local law and include a projected budget for the Office of the Inspector General in the
county's annual operating budget proposal; establishing an Office of the Inspector
General Advisory Board to select and appoint and, under certain circumstances,
remove the Inspector General; and generally relating to the Office of the Inspector
General in Anne Arundel County.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Local Government

- 19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 20 INDICATED.

21 (2) "ADVISORY BOARD" MEANS THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR 22 GENERAL ADVISORY BOARD.

- (3) "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL.

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(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

2 (C) THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL ESTABLISH AN OFFICE OF THE 3 INSPECTOR GENERAL IN THE COUNTY.

4 (D) THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL:

5 (1) ENACT A LOCAL LAW THAT ESTABLISHES:

6 (I) THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE INSPECTOR GENERAL;

7 (II) THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL;

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(III) THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE; AND

9 (IV) ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT THE COUNTY COUNCIL 10 CONSIDERS NECESSARY FOR THE OPERATION OF THE OFFICE; AND

11 (2) INCLUDE IN THE COUNTY'S ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET 12 PROPOSAL A PROJECTED BUDGET FOR THE OFFICE FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL 13 YEAR.

14 (E) (1) THERE IS AN OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL ADVISORY 15 BOARD IN THE COUNTY.

16 (2) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 17 ADVISORY BOARD CONSISTS OF SEVEN MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY 18 EXECUTIVE AND SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

19(3) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY BOARD MAY NOT BE AN ELECTED20OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF:

- 21 **(I)** THE STATE;
- 22 (II) THE COUNTY; OR

23 (III) ANY OTHER FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

24 (4) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE 25 ADVISORY BOARD:

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11.SHALL SELECT AND APPOINT THE INSPECTOR2GENERAL; AND

3 2. MAY REMOVE THE INSPECTOR GENERAL ONLY FOR
4 NEGLECT OF DUTY, MALFEASANCE, CONVICTION OF A FELONY, OR OTHER GOOD
5 CAUSE.

6 (II) AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF THE ADVISORY 7 BOARD IS NECESSARY FOR THE SELECTION, APPOINTMENT, OR REMOVAL OF THE 8 INSPECTOR GENERAL.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2025.
