- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Public Safety
- 14 5-140.

15 (a) A dealer or other person may not transport a regulated firearm into the State 16 for the purpose of unlawfully selling or trafficking of the regulated firearm.

17 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a [misdemeanor] FELONY and 18 on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding 19 \$25,000 or both.

20 (c) Each violation of this section is a separate crime.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2025.
