- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19Article Criminal Law
- 20 12–108.

# (a) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED UNDER § 13–1304(B)(2) OR (3) OF THIS ARTICLE CONDUCTING A GAMING EVENT FOR ITS OWN BENEFIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 13–1304 OF THIS ARTICLE.

#### **SENATE BILL 450**

1 **(B)** An organization that operates a gaming event authorized under this subtitle, 2 Subtitle 2 of this title, or Title 13 of this article may not accept credit from a person to allow 3 that person to play a gaming device at the gaming event.

4 [(b)] (C) Subsection [(a)] (B) of this section does not prohibit an organization 5 from accepting a token instead of money from a person who has paid the organization 6 money for the use of the token.

7 [(c)] (D) An organization that violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor 8 and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or loss of privileges to conduct a 9 gaming event not exceeding 60 days or both.

11 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the 12 organization is:

- 13 (2) a Frederick County volunteer:
- 14 (i) fire company;
- 15 (ii) rescue company; or
- 16 (iii) ambulance company; or
- 17 (3) an auxiliary for a Frederick County volunteer:
- 18 (i) fire company;
- 19 (ii) rescue company; or
- 20 (iii) ambulance company.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2025.
