1 AN ACT concerning

Agriculture – Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency Mechanism Grant Program – Expansion

- FOR the purpose of expanding the Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency Mechanism
 Grant Program by making certain qualified suppliers eligible for grant funding;
 establishing the Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency Operating Fund; and

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (b) "Fund" means the Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency Mechanism

2 (c) "MD FARM" means the Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency 3 Mechanism Grant Program.

4 (D) "OPERATING FUND" MEANS THE MARYLAND FOOD AND 5 AGRICULTURAL RESILIENCY OPERATING FUND.

6 (E) "QUALIFIED SUPPLIER" MEANS A BUSINESS ENTITY OR NONPROFIT 7 ORGANIZATION THAT OPERATES A FARM OR COMMUNITY GARDEN IN THE STATE 8 THAT:

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(1) **OPERATES ON AT LEAST 100 ACRES;**

10 (2) GROWS AT LEAST 1,000,000 POUNDS OF PRODUCE ANNUALLY; 11 AND

12 (3) DONATES AT LEAST 25% OF ITS ANNUAL HARVEST TO THE 13 STATE'S FOOD BANKS AND CHARITABLE EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDERS AT NO COST.

(a) There is a Maryland Food and Agricultural Resiliency Mechanism GrantProgram.

17 (b) The purpose of MD FARM is to build food system resiliency by leveraging 18 Maryland agricultural products and services to support the State's food banks [and], 19 charitable emergency food providers, AND QUALIFIED SUPPLIERS to alleviate food 20 insecurity.

22 (A) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL RESILIENCY 23 OPERATING FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT.

(2) THE PURPOSE OF THE OPERATING FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS
 TO QUALIFIED SUPPLIERS FOR OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH SUPPLYING
 AGRICULTURAL FOOD PRODUCTS TO THE STATE'S FOOD BANKS AND CHARITABLE
 EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDERS.

28 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE OPERATING FUND.

29 (C) (1) THE OPERATING FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS 30 NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

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1 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE OPERATING FUND 2 SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE OPERATING 3 FUND.

4 (D) THE OPERATING FUND CONSISTS OF:

5 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE 6 OPERATING FUND; AND

7 (2) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR 8 THE BENEFIT OF THE OPERATING FUND.

9 (E) THE OPERATING FUND SHALL BE USED TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO 10 QUALIFIED SUPPLIERS FOR OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH SUPPLYING 11 AGRICULTURAL FOOD PRODUCTS TO THE STATE'S FOOD BANKS AND CHARITABLE 12 EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDERS.

13 (F) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 14 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF 15 \$1,000,000 TO THE OPERATING FUND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2025.
