(a) 17 A Hagerstown Community College police officer has the powers granted (1) 18 to a peace and police officer. 19 [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS (2)(i) 20 PARAGRAPH, A Hagerstown Community College police officer may exercise these powers 21 only on property that is owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of Hagerstown 22Community College.
