15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
20	INDICATED.
21	(2) "PROVIDER" MEANS A SCHOOL AUDIOLOGIST, SCHOOL
22	PSYCHOLOGIST, SCHOOL SPEECH PATHOLOGIST, AND ANY OTHER HEALTH CARE
23	PRACTITIONER WHO PROVIDES SERVICES TO A STUDENT IN A SCHOOL SETTING.

- 1 (3) "REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS" MEANS FUNDS RECEIVED BY AN
- 2 ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL, OR A COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM, FOR
- 3 SERVICES PROVIDED IN A SCHOOL SETTING TO AN INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN THE
- 4 MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OR THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S
- 5 HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM.
- 6 (B) AN ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL OR A COUNTY SCHOOL 7 SYSTEM SHALL USE REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS TO PROVIDE:
- 8 (1) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS FOR PROVIDERS;
- 9 (2) PAID INTERNSHIPS FOR STUDENTS SEEKING TO BECOME 10 PROVIDERS;
- 11 (3) STIPENDS FOR PROVIDERS THAT ARE DESIGNED TO ADDRESS
- 12 PROBLEMS IN PROVIDER RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION; AND
- 13 (4) STIPENDS FOR PROVIDERS WORKING IN LOW-PERFORMING
- 14 SCHOOLS THAT ARE DESIGNED TO ADDRESS PROBLEMS IN PROVIDER RECRUITMENT
- 15 AND RETENTION.
- 16 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 17 SECTION.
