 $\mathbf{2}$ **SENATE BILL 522** (2)"New home" includes: 1  $\mathbf{2}$ (i) a custom home as defined in § 10–501(c) of the Real Property 3 Article: a new home to which § 10-301 of the Real Property Article 4 (ii) applies;  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 an industrialized building intended for residential use; and (iii) 7 (iv) a mobile home. 8 (r) "Registrant" means a person registered to build new homes. 9 4.5 - 603.10This subsection applies only to a development that contains 11 or more (a) (1)11 new homes to be built by the same registrant. 12Prior to the execution of any contract for the initial sale of a new home, (2)13a registrant shall provide the purchaser with written information about any energy-efficient options, including a statement that tax credits may be available related to 14 15the energy-efficient options, that are available for installation in the home before 16construction of the home is completed. 17(b) A registrant shall include in any contract for the initial sale of a new home: 18 (1) FOR EACH APPLIANCE IN THE NEW HOME, INCLUDING THE 19HEATING, VENTILATION, AND AIR-CONDITIONING SYSTEM, THAT WAS REGISTERED 20BY THE REGISTRANT, THE WARRANTY INFORMATION FOR THE APPLIANCE, 21**INCLUDING:** 22**(I)** THE DATE THE REGISTRANT REGISTERED THE WARRANTY; 23AND 24**(II)** THE TIME REMAINING UNDER THE WARRANTY; AND 25the information required under 14-117(a)(3), (i), and (m) of the Real (2) Property Article, if applicable. 2627SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28October 1, 2025.
