A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ACT concerning	

State Lottery – Instant Ticket Lottery Machines – Veterans' and Fraternal Organizations

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the State Lottery and Gaming Control 5 Agency to issue certain fraternal organizations a license for not more than a certain 6 number of instant ticket lottery machines; altering the distribution of proceeds from 7 certain instant ticket lottery machine sales by veterans' organizations; providing for 8 the distribution of proceeds from certain instant ticket lottery machine sales by 9 fraternal organizations; authorizing, instead of requiring, the Director to consider certain information before issuing certain licenses; repealing a requirement that 10 11 certain veterans' organizations purchase or lease certain instant ticket lottery 12 machines; prohibiting certain fraternal organizations from operating an instant 13 ticket lottery machine in certain locations; and generally relating to the operation of 14 instant ticket lottery machines in the State.



- 4 (3) (I) "FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION" MEANS A NONPROFIT 5 ORGANIZATION THAT:
- 1. A. IS TAX EXEMPT AND ORGANIZED AS A FRATERNAL OR SORORAL ORGANIZATION UNDER § 501(C)(7) OR § 501(C)(8) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE;

- and governmental units that will best serve the public convenience and promote the sale of
- 30 State lottery tickets or shares.

- 8 (4) **[**(i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a veterans' 9 organization issued a license under this subsection shall purchase or lease the instant 10 ticket lottery machines to be used by the veterans' organization.
- 11 (ii)] An organization may not use receipts from the sale of tickets 12 from instant ticket lottery machines that would otherwise be [credited to the State Lottery 13 Fund] DISTRIBUTED AS REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION for 14 the costs of purchasing or leasing instant ticket lottery machines.
- 15 (5) (I) The Director may adopt regulations to implement the provisions 16 of this subsection that include restricting the location of instant ticket lottery machines in 17 areas of a veterans' organization's OR A FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION'S public meeting 18 hall that is accessible to the public.
- 19 (II) A FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION MAY NOT LOCATE OR 20 OPERATE ITS INSTANT TICKET LOTTERY MACHINES IN A MEETING HALL THAT IS:
- 21 LOCATED ON OR AFFILIATED WITH THE CAMPUS OF 22 AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; OR
- 23 LOCATED IN A BUILDING WHERE STUDENTS OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION RESIDE.
- 25 (6) The Agency shall ensure that the element of chance in the conduct of 26 the gaming through the instant ticket lottery machines established under this subsection 27 is consistent with the holding in the case of Chesapeake Amusements Inc. v. Riddle, 363 28 Md. 16 (2001), in that the element of chance must be wholly within the pre-printed instant 29 lottery ticket, and that player enhancements in an instant ticket lottery machine may not 30 affect the element of chance being wholly within the pre-printed instant lottery ticket.
- 31 (e) The Director may not issue a license to:
- 32 (1) a person or governmental unit to engage in business primarily as a 33 licensed agent; or

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- 1 (2) an individual who is under the age of 21 years.
- 2 (f) The Commission may hear and decide an appeal of a denial of a license.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 $\,$ 1, 2025.
