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Vehicle Laws – Licenses, Identification Cards, and Moped Operator's Permits – Notation of Nonapparent Disability

- FOR the purpose of requiring that certain applications for a license, an identification card, 4 5 or a moped operator's permit allow an applicant to choose to indicate on the 6 document the applicant's nonapparent disability; requiring the Motor Vehicle 7 Administration to ensure that the license, identification card, or moped operator's 8 permit of an applicant who indicates that the applicant has a nonapparent disability 9 includes a certain notation; requiring the Administration to establish certain public outreach efforts on the availability of the notation; prohibiting the Administration 10 11 from disclosing certain information to certain entities about an applicant that 12 indicates that the applicant has a nonapparent disability; and generally relating to nonapparent disability notations on licenses, identification cards, and moped 13 14 operator's permits.

 3 THE ISSUANCE OF A CORRECTED DOCUMENT IF NO OTHER CORRECTIONS ARE MADE.

- 5 (1) REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION 6 CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT TO PROVIDE PROOF OF THE APPLICANT'S NONAPPARENT DISABILITY;
- 8 (2) DENY AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION
 9 CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT BECAUSE THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY
 10 SELECTED BY THE APPLICANT DOES NOT MATCH THE NONAPPARENT DISABILITY

- (F) THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE AND OTHER INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL IMPLEMENT TRAINING CONCERNING INTERACTIONS WITH INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE A NONAPPARENT DISABILITY NOTATION ON THEIR LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
