A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary’s County – Judgeships – Circuit Courts**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of resident judges of the circuit courts by adding
4 one additional judgeship in St. Mary’s County; and generally relating to judgeships
5 in the circuit courts.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 1–503.

15 (a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the number of
16 resident judges of the circuit court set forth below, including the judge or judges provided
17 for by the Constitution:

- 18 (1) Allegany..... 2
- 19 (2) Anne Arundel 13
- 20 (3) Baltimore County..... 21
- 21 (4) Calvert..... 3
