Garrett County - Bids and Contracts - Advertisement Exceptions

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that, in Garrett County, a certain requirement to advertise
- 4 for bids does not apply to a certain contract for goods or services procured on an
- 5 as-needed basis over time or for certain vehicles; and generally relating to
- 6 procurement in Garrett County.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article 12 – Garrett County

- 16 (A) (1) Except for transactions under PARAGRAPHS (5) AND (6) OF THIS
- 17 **DIVISION OR** division (D) of this section, professional services required to be licensed by
- 18 the State of Maryland, or as otherwise authorized by law, the County Commissioners, or
- 19 any employee of Garrett County, may not enter into any contract of sale or purchase to
- which the county is a party where the amount involved under the contract exceeds \$50,000
- 21 without advertising for bids in one or more newspapers circulated in the county.
- 22 Professional services required to be licensed by the State of Maryland may be solicited by
- 23 written bids.

- 1 (2) The advertisement for bids shall appear at least a week prior to the date 2 on which bids are to be filed.
- 3 (3) Any contract of sale shall be awarded to the highest responsible bidder, 4 and any contract of purchase shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, but the 5 County Commissioners shall have the right to reject any and all bids.
- 6 (4) Any contract entered into in violation of the provisions of this section 7 shall be null and void. The provisions of this section shall not apply to necessary repairs 8 made in case of emergency.
- 9 (5) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OR ANY EMPLOYEE OF GARRETT
 10 COUNTY, MAY ENTER INTO A PURCHASE OR WORK PROJECT CONTRACT FOR AN
 11 INDETERMINATE AMOUNT OF GOODS OR SERVICES PROCURED ON AN AS-NEEDED
 12 BASIS OVER A PERIOD OF TIME WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS UNDER
 13 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS DIVISION. THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES REGARDLESS OF
 14 WHETHER THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL EXCEEDS \$50,000.
- 15 (6) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OR ANY EMPLOYEE OF GARRETT
 16 COUNTY, MAY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE OR MORE
 17 VEHICLES FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$100,000 WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS
 18 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS DIVISION.
- 19 **[**(5)**] (7)** If any County Commissioner shall violate any provisions of this division, the Commissioner shall be liable to indictment, and, upon conviction, shall forfeit the office.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
