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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Garrett County – Bids and Contracts – Advertisement Exceptions**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that, in Garrett County, a certain requirement to advertise  
4 for bids does not apply to a certain contract for goods or services procured on an  
5 as-needed basis over time or for certain vehicles; and generally relating to  
6 procurement in Garrett County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 The Public Local Laws of Garrett County  
9 Section 30.21(A)  
10 Article 12 – Public Local Laws of Maryland  
11 (2005 Edition and 2022 Supplement, as amended)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 12 – Garrett County**

15 30.21.

16 (A) (1) Except for transactions under **PARAGRAPHS (5) AND (6) OF THIS**  
17 **DIVISION OR** division (D) of this section, professional services required to be licensed by  
18 the State of Maryland, or as otherwise authorized by law, the County Commissioners, or  
19 any employee of Garrett County, may not enter into any contract of sale or purchase to  
20 which the county is a party where the amount involved under the contract exceeds \$50,000

1 without advertising for bids in one or more newspapers circulated in the county.  
 2 Professional services required to be licensed by the State of Maryland may be solicited by  
 3 written bids.

4 (2) The advertisement for bids shall appear at least a week prior to the date  
 5 on which bids are to be filed.

6 (3) Any contract of sale shall be awarded to the highest responsible bidder,  
 7 and any contract of purchase shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, but the  
 8 County Commissioners shall have the right to reject any and all bids.

9 (4) Any contract entered into in violation of the provisions of this section  
 10 shall be null and void. The provisions of this section shall not apply to necessary repairs  
 11 made in case of emergency.

12 **(5) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OR ANY EMPLOYEE OF GARRETT**  
 13 **COUNTY, MAY ENTER INTO A PURCHASE OR WORK PROJECT CONTRACT FOR AN**  
 14 **INDETERMINATE AMOUNT OF GOODS OR SERVICES PROCURED ON AN AS-NEEDED**  
 15 **BASIS OVER A PERIOD OF TIME WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS UNDER**  
 16 **PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS DIVISION. THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES REGARDLESS OF**  
 17 **WHETHER THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL EXCEEDS \$50,000.**

18 **(6) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OR ANY EMPLOYEE OF GARRETT**  
 19 **COUNTY, MAY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE OR MORE**  
 20 **VEHICLES FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$100,000 WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS**  
 21 **UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS DIVISION.**

22 ~~[(5)]~~ (7) If any County Commissioner shall violate any provisions of this  
 23 division, the Commissioner shall be liable to indictment, and, upon conviction, shall forfeit  
 24 the office.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 26 October 1, 2025.
