SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Election Law 12 8-201. 13 14(a) (1)There shall be a statewide primary election in every even-numbered 15year. (2)16 A primary election shall be held: 17in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the [last] (i) FOURTH Tuesday in June; and 18
