A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Business Regulation – Miscellaneous State Business Licenses – Enforcement and Penalties

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Comptroller to issue citations to enforce certain
provisions of law concerning business licenses; requiring each application for a
certain business license to designate an individual to serve as the license
representative for the purpose of being subject to certain penalties; establishing that
the penalties for violating certain provisions of law apply to certain persons; and
generally relating to penalties and enforcement for miscellaneous State business
licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(B) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this title, a person who violates
 this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding
 \$300 or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days.

17 [(b)] (C) Each [agent or officer of a corporation] PERSON WHO IS convicted of 18 violating this subtitle [who actually engaged in the unlicensed business is] MAY BE 19 individually subject to the penalties provided by law.

20 [(c)] (D) The penalty provided in this section does not affect any other penalty 21 specifically provided by law for a violation of a license law.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2025.
