 4 SHALL BE EXPUNGED 3 YEARS AFTER THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGING COMMITTEE
 5 DETERMINES THAT THE POLICE OFFICER WILL NOT BE ADMINISTRATIVELY
 6 CHARGED.
