A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Dental Examiners – Expanded Function Dental Assistants –**
3 **Education and Reinstatement**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Dental Examiners to approve a certain
5 course of study for expanded function dental assistant certification; requiring that a
6 course of study for initial dental assistant certification include an option for an online
7 course of study when appropriate; requiring the Board to reinstate an expired
8 expanded function dental assistant certification only under certain circumstances;
9 requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations relating to continuing education for
10 expanded function dental assistants; and generally relating to expanded function
11 dental assistants.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 **Article – Health Occupations**

25 4–302.1.

1 (a) To qualify for a certificate to be an expanded function dental assistant, an
2 applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.

3 (b) The applicant must be of good moral character.

4 (c) The applicant must be at least 18 years old.

5 (d) The applicant must:

6 (1) Be a high school graduate or have attained a high school equivalency;

7 (2) Have successfully completed a course of study approved, subject to
8 subsection (e) of this section, by the Board related to the intraoral procedure for which the
9 applicant has applied for a certificate;

10 (3) Have the appropriate certification from the Dental Assisting National
11 Board;

12 (4) Have passed any examination provided for in a regulation adopted by
13 the Board; and

14 (5) Submit to a State criminal history records check.

15 (e) The Board may not approve a course of study under subsection (d)(2) of this
16 section unless the course of study is part of:

17 (1) A U.S. Department of Labor Job Corps dental assisting program;

18 (2) A dental assisting program located within an institution of
19 postsecondary education that is accredited by an accrediting institution recognized by the
20 U.S. Department of Education;

21 (3) A dental assisting program that is located within a high school and is
22 recognized by an accrediting body recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or the
23 high school accrediting body of a state; [or]

24 (4) A dental assisting program that is accredited by the Council on Dental
25 Accreditation, or a successor organization;

26 **(5) A DENTAL ASSISTING COURSE OR PROGRAM OFFERED BY THE**
27 **DALE FOUNDATION, AN AFFILIATE OF THE DENTAL ASSISTING NATIONAL BOARD,**
28 **OR ANY SUCCESSOR ENTITY; OR**

29 **(6) AN ORTHODONTIC DENTAL ASSISTING COURSE OR PROGRAM**
30 **OFFERED BY THE TRAPEZIO ORTHODONTIC ASSISTANT TRAINING SOLUTIONS, OR**
31 **ANY SUCCESSOR ENTITY.**

1 **(F) A COURSE OF STUDY FOR INITIAL CERTIFICATION UNDER THIS SECTION**
2 **SHALL INCLUDE, WHEN APPROPRIATE, AN OPTION FOR AN ONLINE COURSE OF**
3 **STUDY.**

5 **(A) THE BOARD SHALL REINSTATE AN EXPANDED FUNCTION DENTAL**
6 **ASSISTANT CERTIFICATE THAT IS EXPIRED ONLY IF THE HOLDER:**

7 **(1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, HAS COMPLETED**
8 **THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SET BY RULE AND REGULATION OF**
9 **THE BOARD;**

10 **(2) HAS SUBMITTED A RENEWAL APPLICATION TO THE BOARD**
11 **BEFORE THE DEADLINE SET BY THE BOARD; AND**

12 **(3) PAYS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD.**

13 **(B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS REQUIRING CONTINUING**
14 **EDUCATION FOR EXPANDED FUNCTION DENTAL ASSISTANTS TO:**

15 **(1) INCLUDE AN OPTION FOR AN ONLINE COURSE OF STUDY; AND**

16 **(2) BE OFFERED BY:**

17 **(I) DENTAL PROFESSIONAL SOCIETIES AFFILIATED WITH**
18 **NATIONAL DENTAL ORGANIZATIONS; AND**

19 **(II) ENTITIES LISTED IN § 4-302.1(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2025.
