- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Dental Examiners to approve a certain 5 course of study for expanded function dental assistant certification; requiring that a 6 course of study for initial dental assistant certification include an option for an a 7 certain number of hours of in-person and online course of study when appropriate instruction; requiring the Board to reinstate an expired expanded function dental 8 9 assistant certification only under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to 10 adopt certain regulations relating to continuing education for expanded function 11 dental assistants; and generally relating to expanded function dental assistants.

The applicant must be at least 18 years old. 8 (c) 9 (d) The applicant must: 10 (1) Be a high school graduate or have attained a high school equivalency; Have successfully completed a course of study approved, subject to 11 (2)12 subsection (e) of this section, by the Board related to the intraoral procedure for which the applicant has applied for a certificate; 13 14 Have the appropriate certification from the Dental Assisting National (3) 15 Board: 16 Have passed any examination provided for in a regulation adopted by **(4)** 17 the Board; and 18 (5)Submit to a State criminal history records check. 19 The Board may not approve a course of study under subsection (d)(2) of this 20 section unless the course of study is part of: 21A U.S. Department of Labor Job Corps dental assisting program; (1) 22(2) A dental assisting program located within an institution of 23postsecondary education that is accredited by an accrediting institution recognized by the 24U.S. Department of Education; 25(3) A dental assisting program that is located within a high school and is 26 recognized by an accrediting body recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or the 27 high school accrediting body of a state; [or]
