1 AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Venue Beer, Wine, and Liquor License

FOR the purpose of establishing in Dorchester County a venue beer, wine, and liquor 4 license that authorizes the holder to sell or serve beer, wine, and liquor for $\mathbf{5}$ 6 on-premises consumption during an event where food is served; authorizing the 7 Board of License Commissioners for Dorchester County to issue the license to a nonprofit or for-profit retail business that hosts private or public events at a venue 8 9 that meets certain criteria; authorizing the Board to issue the license to an 10 establishment that is within a certain distance of a place of worship or school with 11 the written consent of the place of worship or school; and generally relating to 12 alcoholic beverages licenses in Dorchester County.
