1 AN ACT concerning

- FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to collect data on energy usage and report the data collected to the Interagency Commission on School Construction; requiring the Commission to adopt regulations specifying the data to be collected and the means and frequency of reporting; requiring the Commission to analyze the data collected and provide recommendations for improving school building energy efficiency and usage; and generally relating to school building energy usage.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 **5–331.**
- 18 (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL:
- 19 (1) COLLECT DATA ON SCHOOL BUILDING ENERGY USAGE; AND
- 20 (2) REPORT THE DATA COLLECTED TO THE INTERAGENCY 21 COMMISSION.



- 1 (B) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT 2 SPECIFY:
- 3 (1) THE DATA TO BE COLLECTED; AND
- 4 (2) THE MEANS AND FREQUENCY OF REPORTING.
- 5 (C) THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION SHALL ANALYZE THE DATA 6 COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION AND PROVIDE 7 RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNTY BOARD FOR IMPROVING SCHOOL BUILDING 8 ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND USAGE.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2025.
