A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Family Law – Treatment Foster Care Homes – Child Care Stipends for Private Providers

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, beginning in a certain fiscal year, the Secretary of Human $\mathbf{5}$ Services to review and reallocate a portion of the Department of Human Services' 6 annual budget to be used to provide child care stipends to certain private treatment 7 foster care homes to cover child care expenses; requiring, beginning in a certain fiscal 8 year, the Secretary to include in the Department's annual budget proposal certain 9 funding for child care stipends for private treatment foster care homes; requiring the Secretary to adopt certain procedures to award child care stipends to private 10 11 treatment foster care homes; and generally relating to treatment foster care homes.

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1 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

2 (3) "Treatment foster care home" means an out-of-home placement facility 3 that is part of a program designed and implemented by a child placement agency to provide 4 intensive casework and treatment in a family setting to children with special physical, 5 emotional, or behavioral needs.

(2) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN SERVICES.

10 (3) "TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOME" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 11 § 5–525.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

12(1) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2026 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR **(B)** THEREAFTER, AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY 13SHALL, BEFORE SUBMITTING A BUDGET PROPOSAL UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 14SUBSECTION, REVIEW AND REALLOCATE A PORTION OF THE DEPARTMENT'S 15ANNUAL BUDGET TO BE USED FOR PROVIDING CHILD CARE STIPENDS TO PRIVATE 16 17TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOMES TO COVER CHILD CARE EXPENSES IN A SIMILAR 18 MANNER AS PUBLIC TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOMES.

19 (2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 20 THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE DEPARTMENT'S ANNUAL BUDGET 21 PROPOSAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT A REQUEST FOR 22 AN AMOUNT OF FUNDING THAT IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING 23 THE SECRETARY REALLOCATED FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR FOR PRIVATE 24 TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOMES IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 25 SUBSECTION.

(C) WHEN REVIEWING WHETHER ANY FUNDS SHOULD BE REALLOCATED
UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL DETERMINE
THE REALLOCATION BASED ON THE FUNDING NEEDS FOR EACH LOCAL
DEPARTMENT THAT WORKS WITH PRIVATE TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOMES AND
THE FAMILIES OF THE CHILDREN BEING PLACED IN A HOME.

(D) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
 SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION, INCLUDING
 APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA FOR AWARDING CHILD CARE STIPENDS
 TO PRIVATE TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOMES UNDER THIS SECTION.

1(2) THE APPLICATION PROCEDURES DEVELOPED UNDER2PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL REQUIRE THAT A PRIVATE TREATMENT3FOSTER CARE HOME:

4 (I) MEET OR EXCEED THE SAME STANDARDS AS A PUBLIC 5 TREATMENT FOSTER CARE HOME WITH RESPECT TO EQUITY STANDARDS AND 6 CULTURAL COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS; AND

7 (II) DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE BASED ON RACE, COLOR,
8 RELIGION, SEX, AGE, NATIONAL ORIGIN, MARITAL STATUS, SEXUAL ORIENTATION,
9 GENDER IDENTITY, OR DISABILITY WHEN PROVIDING SERVICES OR PLACEMENTS.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 11 1, 2025.
