5 (G) (1) THE AGENCY MAY ALLOW A LICENSED AGENT TO ENTER INTO AN 6 AGREEMENT WITH A THIRD–PARTY ENTITY TO ALLOW THE ENTITY TO PURCHASE A 7 STATE LOTTERY TICKET ON BEHALF OF AN INDIVIDUAL IN THE STATE AND DELIVER 8 THE TICKET TO THE INDIVIDUAL IN THE STATE.

9 (2) A THIRD-PARTY ENTITY MAY CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR 10 PROVIDING THE SERVICES DESCRIBED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SECTION.
