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### 1 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS 2 OF THE COVERAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before June 1, 2026, 4 the Maryland Department of Health shall provide notice to Maryland Medical Assistance 5 Program recipients of the coverage required by this Act in writing, and prominently 6 positioned in any literature or correspondence sent to Program recipients about coverage 7 available under the Program in calendar year 2026.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2025.
