A BILL ENTITLED

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Employment – Wages – Deductions for Public Employees

- FOR the purpose of applying to governmental employers certain provisions of the Maryland
 Wage Payment and Collection Law that prohibit an employer from making
 deductions from the wage of an employee except for specified purposes; allowing a
 governmental employer to make a deduction from a public employee's wage if the
 deduction is authorized expressly in a compensation or benefit plan adopted by the
 employer; and generally relating to wage deductions under the Maryland Wage
 Payment and Collection Law.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EMPLOYER" INCLUDES A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- 20 **(B)** An employer may not make a deduction from the wage of an employee unless 21 the deduction is:
- 22 (1) ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction;

2	(3) allowed by the Commissioner because the employee has received full

4	(4) AUTHORIZED EXPRESSLY IN A COMPENSATION OR BENEFIT PLAN

9	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10	October 1, 2025.
