- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

28 OFFICIATING SERVICES, THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM:

1(I)MAY NOT SET SEPARATE DEADLINES FOR THE SUBMISSION2OF BIDS AND OFFERS FOR BOYS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS OFFICIATING SERVICES AND3GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS OFFICIATING SERVICES; AND

4 (II) MAY REQUIRE THAT PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS OR OFFERORS 5 PARTNER TO ENSURE THAT BIDS AND OFFERS FOR BOYS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS 6 OFFICIATING SERVICES ARE ACCOMPANIED BY BIDS AND OFFERS FOR GIRLS' HIGH 7 SCHOOL SPORTS OFFICIATING SERVICES.

8 **(**D**)** A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL REJECT A BID OR PROPOSAL IF 9 ENTERING INTO A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT BASED ON THE BID OR PROPOSAL WOULD RESULT, FOR SIMILAR BOYS' AND GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS, IN THE RATE 10 OF PAY OR ASSIGNING FEES RECEIVED BY INDIVIDUALS OFFICIATING GIRLS' HIGH 11 SCHOOL SPORTS OR ASSIGNING GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS OFFICIALS BEING 1213DIFFERENT FROM THE RATE OF PAY OR ASSIGNING FEES FOR INDIVIDUALS 14OFFICIATING BOYS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS OR ASSIGNING BOYS' HIGH SCHOOL 15SPORTS OFFICIALS.

16 (E) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT THE PAYMENT OF 17 ASSIGNING FEES AS A BONUS THAT IS PAID OUTSIDE A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.

18 **(F)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY DEVELOP GUIDELINES TO ASSIST A LOCAL 19 SCHOOL SYSTEM IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, 20 INCLUDING ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING WHICH HIGH SCHOOL 21 SPORTS QUALIFY AS SIMILAR BOYS' AND GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) A local school system that executed a procurement contract for high school
sports officiating services, as defined in § 4–147 of the Education Article, as enacted by
Section 1 of this Act, on or before July 1, 2025, may extend the term of the contract to align
the contract timelines for similar boys' and girls' high school sports.

27 (b) A local school system may not extend a contract under subsection (a) of this 28 section beyond July 1, 2029.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except for a contract for high school sports officials extended by a local school system in accordance with Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any procurement contracts for high school sports officiating services, as defined in § 4–147 of the Education Article, as enacted under Section 1 of this Act, entered into before the effective date of this Act.
