15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
21 22	(2) (I) "BUILDING" MEANS A STRUCTURE WITH EXTERIOR WALLS THAT COMBINE TO FORM AN OCCUPIABLE STRUCTURE.



- 1 (II) "BUILDING" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TEMPORARY 2 STRUCTURE, AS DEFINED IN THE HOWARD COUNTY BUILDING CODE.
- 3 (3) "NEW CONSTRUCTION" MEANS CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING 4 THAT REQUIRES A HOWARD COUNTY BUILDING PERMIT.
- 5 (B) When determining the minimum number of mandatory parking 6 Spaces for New Construction, the Howard County Department of 7 Planning and Zoning shall consider whether infrastructure for 8 Pedestrians could offset the need for the construction of any parking 9 Spaces for the new construction.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
