A BILL ENTITLED

2 Maryland Department of Health – Patient Navigation Services – Study

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to conduct a study on patient navigation services in the State; and generally relating to patient navigation services.

 $\,\,$ SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 7 $\,\,$ That:

- (a) In this section, "patient navigation" means individualized assistance offered to a patient with cancer and the patient's family and caregivers at the health care facility at which the patient is receiving care.
- (b) The Maryland Department of Health, in consultation with stakeholders including stakeholders with policy, clinical, or personal expertise, shall conduct a study on patient navigation services that help a patient overcome health care system barriers and facilitate timely access to quality health and psychosocial care from prediagnosis through all phases of the cancer experience.
- 16 (c) The Maryland Department of Health shall:
- 17 (1) in conducting the study required under subsection (b) of this section:
 - (i) assess the availability of patient navigation services; and
- 19 (ii) analyze the barriers to accessing patient navigation services; and
- 20 (2) recommend policy, legislative, and budgetary initiatives to improve 21 patient navigation services in the State.



- 1 (d) On or before December 1, 2025, the Maryland Department of Health shall 2 report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 3 2–1257 of the State Government Article.
- $_{\rm 4}$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 5 $\,$ 1, 2025.
