3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) beer, wine, and liquor license 4 in Howard County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Howard $\mathbf{5}$ County to issue the license to the owner of a movie theater who holds a certain 6 certification; authorizing the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor to certain 7 patrons at retail for on-premises consumption; authorizing the Board to set the 8 hours and days of sale for the license and the annual license fee certain limitations 9 on and requirements for the license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in 10 Howard County.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
26	1, 2025.
