# 2 Natural Resources - Vessels - Carbon Monoxide Warning Labels 3 (<u>Matthew's Law</u>)

  vessel manufactured after a certain date that has a cabin or other closed living space
  on the waters of the State unless the vessel has carbon monoxide warning labels
  affixed in conspicuous locations in certain areas of the vessel; prohibiting the
  Department of Natural Resources from imposing a certain penalty; and generally
  relating to the State Boat Act.

1(A)IN THIS SECTION, "MOTORIZED VESSEL" DOES NOT INCLUDE A VESSEL2POWERED BY AN ELECTRIC MOTOR.

3 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT OPERATE A GASOLINE-POWERED MOTORIZED 4 VESSEL MANUFACTURED AFTER JULY 31, 2007, THAT HAS A CABIN OR OTHER 5 CLOSED LIVING SPACE ON THE WATERS OF THE STATE UNLESS THE VESSEL HAS 6 CARBON MONOXIDE WARNING LABELS AFFIXED IN CONSPICUOUS LOCATIONS IN THE 7 VICINITY OF BOTH THE TRANSOM AND THE HELM OF THE VESSEL.

#### 8 (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT IMPOSE A PENALTY ON A PERSON THAT 9 VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2025.
