The African American Resources-Cultural and Heritage Society identifies, collects, preserves and makes publicly accessible through our programs and services the objects, artifacts and stories about the history, rich heritage and culture and the contributions of African Americans in Frederick County, past and present, and in doing so educate, enrich and enlighten this and future generations.					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The AARCH Society is creating a Heritage Center that directly supports the Frederick County's vision for enhancing the quality of life and supporting the arts and creative community. In partnership with the City of Frederick, the Society is transforming a vacant property, in the heart of Frederick's historic district, into a vibrant cultural institution that will enrich the community and visitors through exhibits, multidisciplinary programs, and the collection, preservation, and display of artifacts, documents and material culture. The City of Frederick signed a renewable 10-year lease with the AARCH Society to convert a long-vacant city-owned property into an African American Heritage Center. Previously operated as a fitness center, the 3,200 square foot space requires extensive renovation to meet this intended use, and to comply with building codes and accessibility requirements scheduled for the Spring of 2025 at an estimated cost of almost \$900,000.
