The American Legion Post 175 ("Legion") serves veterans, Anne Arundel County, and the local community by offering personal services, events, and support services to veterans and their families. Severn River Rugby Football Club ("Rugby Club") seeks to grow the support of rugby throughout the county and Central Maryland by fostering competitive teams at the youth, high school, college, and adult levels at the USA Rugby standard of play. The Legion and the Rugby Club continue to enjoy a relationship that spans 23 years. The partnership is based on their alignment of shared values including: service, community engagement, youth education, respect, equal opportunity, and integrity.						

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The American Legion Post 175 requests fund to improve its fields and facilities at its property located at 832 Manhattan Beach Rd. in Severna Park. The improvement includes: purchasing and installing additional lighting on its two acre field, parking/resurfacing, and ceiling and floor improvements in its community hall. The additional field lighting includes: laying wire, and the installation of poles, LED lights, and fixtures. These lights will enable the Legion to continue to support the home pitch of the Rugby Club by allowing the four adult teams and various youth teams to increase the number of practice times and clinics available to the community. In order to accommodate the Legion's growing community participation, funds will also be used to provide additional parking and resurfacing and make needed improvements to the ceiling and floor of their basement community hall.

Severn River Rugby Football Club (tax-exempt organization) and the American Legion Post 175 (tax-exempt organization) have been partners since 1992. The Rugby Club has grown to support over 80 youth and adult active players and 280 alumni each season. While the majority of our members reside in District 33C, members also hail from throughout Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, and Baltimore, Queen Anne, Prince Georges, Montgomery and Harford Counties.
With the support of the Legion through field access, the Rugby Club continues to expand since its founding (1978) in Severna Park. It has grown the sport of rugby for youth, high school students, and adults by hosting weekly matches, holding and participating in national qualifying tournaments, college tournaments, and national playoff matches. The Rugby Club continues to provide free clinic to youth rugby players of all ages and skill levels. Our active players and alumni have grown our volunteer effort by coaching and refereeing for youth rugby clubs and tournaments (Severna Park Green Hornets, Maryland Valkyrie, Howard County Hurricane, and North Bay Youth Rugby.
