10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>American Legion Post 7 is a 501 (c)(19) Non-Profit organization. One of the oldest American Legion posts, established in 1919. Post 7 has a proud history of serving veterans, their families and thousands in the community via two-dozen outreach programs. The American Legion is a national community-based organization focused on supporting Veterans, Youth, Americanism, and National Security. Aligned with these pillars, Post 7 hosts veteran support groups and families, sponsors American Legion youth baseball teams, charter holder for Scouting America Troop 396, and supports the Crownsville Veterans Cemetery. Beyond the mission of the Legion, our hall is used as a polling location and to support various community activities such as Post Office employees, Fish & Wildlife, Agriculture, RenFest, and the Naval Academy.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The 35-year-old facility is showing its age and requires new equipment and renovations to remain safe, enhance accessibility for disabled patrons, and meet sanitation codes to continue to serve (reduced price) award-winning meals to the 700 veterans, families and guests. Safety barriers/bollards are required in specific area around the building facility to protect HVAC equipment. The kitchen needs new equipment, many of which were purchased second-hand, including stoves, fryers, warmers, ice machines and a walk-in cooler. Our detailed request, complete with contactor bids, includes a new digital street sign and replace driveway entry safety lighting. In addition, the Post needs to provide a concrete sidewalk to replace gravel pathway to outdoor grove facilities/picnic tables. Post has a majority of aged/handicapped members/patrons wanting access to the firepit, picnic area and outdoor games. Replace worn, faded and damage building siding.
