**28. Comments**

This project will assist the Baltimore County Volunteer Firefighter's Association, Water Resource Committee with repairing, replacing, and installing new Dry Hydrants in Baltimore County. This will improve the availability of water for fire protection in approximately 2/3 of Baltimore County that is not serviced by Fire Hydrants. The project sites will primarily be along County and State Roadways. Working with those agencies to have equipment installed on their bridges or culverts.  
Once installed the proposed equipment installed will be inspected and maintained by the BCVFA and the Baltimore County Fire Department
