10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Baltimore Humane Society, founded in 1927, saves, protects and cares for thousands of homeless animals in the Baltimore Community each year. Open to the public, we operate a full service Pet Adoption Center, a low-cost, subsidized Spay, Neuter & Vaccine Clinic, which assists in helping control the epidemic of pet overpopulation and it serves low-income pet owners with quality pet care and vaccinations. In addition, our Baltimore Humane Society Pet Cemetery, located on the grounds of BHS, providing a beautiful resting place for pets offering burial, funeral, and cremation services, free pet bereavement services for pet owners and special memorial events. Three hundred and forty three acres of our land still serves as a protected wildlife sanctuary, alive with deer, fox, several species of birds, and numerous other types of local wildlife.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

For over 70 years, our pet cemetery has served as a final resting place for over 10,000 pets in our community providing a serene setting for pet owners to remember & share their hearts for a beloved deceased pet. We offer full cremation, funeral & burial services on our protected wildlife sanctuary grounds that is under a restricted deed, which means a pets final resting space will always be here. Our pet memorial services are a vital revenue stream for our overall shelter operation. The purpose of this project is to expand the cemetery grounds on our property because we are almost out of space for future burials. Being the only dedicated pet cemetery in the region, the community is dependent on our burial services and this project will enable us to service future pet burial needs for pet owners. The expansion area is an open space design with natural burial plots allowing wildlife to flourish.
