Bowie High School is a public school and part of the Prince George's County Public School system. It is a neighborhood school that is split into two campuses. The main building was built in 1965. The main building's infrastructure is aging and in need of many renovations. The freshmen campus was renovated in 2022, but the security camera systems were not replaced.

This project would enable to installation of new security camera systems in the Bowie High School Main Building and Freshmen Campus. Currently, the security camera system is antiquated and disjointed. The software can no longer be updated because the central company no longer manages the technology. The cameras all operate on different servers and have different clocks. So cameras pointed one direction will have a different time than cameras pointing the other direction. The video quality is low and it is difficult to discern what's going on in the videos. An updated camera system building wide would help the administration and security team to keep all students safe and support the staff's efforts to keep students focused on learning and positive community building.
