10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
Edmonston is a town located in Prince George's County with a total population of 1,609 residents. Edmonston is diverse community with 62.9% Hispanic population, 29.2% Black and 8.2% White. It is .42 sq. mil, offering full services of police, public works, and general government to our residents. The Town is committed to providing all the necessary services at the highest level to our residents, businesses and visitors ensuring a premium quality of life is maintained, providing a safe and clean environment for all persons, and planning for the					

future with the support and cooperation of our community. This will be accomplished without regard to race, color, gender, age, marital status, sexual orientation, national origin, religion or

belief, political affiliation, opinion or disability.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Edmonston Town Hall was constructed in 1957 with a small meeting room for the Mayor and Town Council, along with administrative offices for Police and General Government that the Town has outgrown. In addition, the Town could potentially not have use of the Edmonston Recreation Center, owned by Maryland National Capital and Planning. Town Hall is needed to be the "town center" space for congregating and socializing. The renovation will add 1,850 sq. ft. that will provide additional space as a room for public meetings, training, workshops, and a space for residents to gather. It will also provide additional space for the Police operations.
