10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
The City of Gaithersburg is a municipal governmental organization responsible for providing myriad services for its approximately 70,000 residents. Nearly 500 full and part time employees are employed by the city, providing services that include police, planning and zoning, parks and recreation, and public works. The City is administered by a Mayor/City Council-City Manager style of government. The total FY25 Adopted total expenditure budget for the City of Gaithersburg is \$129.5 million.					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

With the acquisition of a private home in 1958, Gaithersburgs current City Hall was established. Renovations were made in 1989 and an addition increased the size of the facility to 27,393 sq ft. Meanwhile, the community's population grew from 32,000 in 1990 to 70,000 in 2022. The City now operates from an undersized, obsolete building on an L-shaped site that constrains future expansion and the potential to demolish and replace the structure. City staff identified an existing office building at 12 South Summit Ave that meets the criteria for a new municipal center. The existing City Hall requires approximately \$10+ million in renovations, which would not increase square footage to accommodate present staffing needs. Departments are spread across multiple buildings and staff assigned to noncontiguous spaces, even on different floors. The public lobby, restrooms, and meeting spaces are also not sized appropriately for the volume of employees and visitors.
