10 Description and Purpose of Organizat					

Genesee Valley Outdoor Learning Center (GVOLC) offers exceptional learning experiences that foster personal growth and development for individuals of all ages and backgrounds. We lead in experiential education, focusing on learning through experience, healthy risk-taking, and relationship-building. Our vision is a world where individuals shape their own growth and empower others. Over 43 years, GVOLC has served over 1,000,000 participants from MD, DE, PA, and VA. Through team-building, nature-based preschool, summer camp, and leadership programs, participants step outside their comfort zones, developing skills in communication, problem-solving, and resilience.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

GVOLC is fortunate to have access to 140 acres of outdoor space, but it currently lacks a modern, multi-purpose indoor facility to better serve the diverse groups that rely on our programs. The new Welcome Center will provide handicap-accessible conference rooms and expanded office space for staff. This facility will allow us to accommodate an additional 15,000 participants annually and expand winter programming. It will also serve as a vital resource for the local community. In the Hereford Zone, there are limited options for community groups to meet, plan programs, or establish a base of operations. The Welcome Center will fill this gap, offering an accessible space for individuals and organizations to come together. This building represents an investment in GVOLC's growth and a commitment to fostering community connections, providing a hub that will serve this region for generations.
